
Marking Your Ballot

## Correcting Your Ballot



If you make a correction or mismark your ballot, draw a line through the entire response. You then have the option of making another choice if you wish.

In order for your ballot to be counted, it must be either postmarked or deposited at a designated deposit site no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day (August 6).
