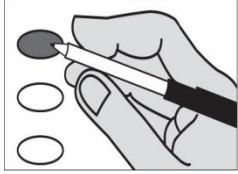

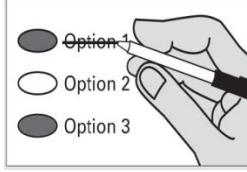
Marking Your Ballot



Completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice.
 Use a dark blue or black pen.

Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for contest will be an overvote and no votes for that ballot contest will be counted. Vote for one candidate per office. To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the name on the line provided and fill in the oval.

Correcting Your Ballot



If you make a correction or mismatch your ballot, draw a line through the entire response. You then have the option of making another choice if you wish. In order for your ballot to be counted, it must be either postmarked or deposited at a designated deposit site no later than 8:00 P.M. on Election Day (November 7, 2017).

**Advisory Vote No. 16
 Engrossed Substitute House Bill 1597**

The legislature increased, without a vote of the people, the food fish excise tax rate on certain salmon and game fish, costing less than \$1,000,000 in the first ten years, for government spending. This tax increase should be:

 Engrossed House Bill 2163**

**Advisory Vote No. 18
 Engrossed House Bill 2242**

The legislature imposed, without a vote of the people, an additional state property tax for common schools, costing \$12,949,000,000 in the first ten years, for government spending. This tax increase should be:

Proposition to Increase Property Tax Levy

The Spokane County Fire Protection District No. 5 Board of Commissioners adopted Resolution No. 17-1 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District Operations. This proposition would increase the Districts regular tax levy to \$1.48 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation in 2017 for collection in 2018. These funds will maintain and improve fire protection and emergency medical services, replace apparatus, equipment, construct a fire house, and provide for firefighter safety. The maximum allowable levy 2017 shall serve as the base for computing subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW for 15 years. Should this proposition be:
