Training Director Tony Anderman:

- Since Oct 2022 spending 20-30 hours with CJTC
- 4-5 months updated curriculum to be rolled out.
- 10-12 weeks post academy may be narrowed to 2-3 weeks after new curriculum/academy.
- Courses are being piloted.
- Mid-June certified (hopefully)
- Takes 48 hours to create 1 hour of curriculum.
- Strategic plan of Training
 - Make sure curriculum of FTO program is tied into CJTC program.
 - Make sure job task analysis program is tied into SCSO program.
- FTO and In-Service Training is a priority.
 - Recommendation from supervisors
 - Must have 3 years in the department.
- Recruiting and retention plans are currently being worked on.
 - o 40 recruiters
 - Looking at historical trends
 - Recruiting through advertising, recruiting team, and enhanced compensation packages.
