AGENDA / MINUTES:

1. **Welcome and Introductions – Kim Taylor, Chair**
 - a. Roll Call (Board quorum present)
 - b. The September 2022 minutes were approved as written.
 - c. Board Member Update - new member Gail Kogle
2. **Presentation – Monthly Behavioral Health Forum – Gail Kogle, Program Director East, Office of Behavioral Health Advocacy (OBHA):** A brief overview of the forum was provided. A new outreach monthly Zoom meeting will be available every second Wednesday of each month. The meeting will explain the current issues the OBHA is solving. The next meeting is scheduled for February 8, 2023, and Gail will provide a meeting link to distribute to the board.
3. **Presentation - 2022 Q3 Crisis Data Dashboard – Katy Rice, SCRBH (ASO):** A brief overview of the data was provided. Frontier Behavioral Health recalculated and corrected their abandonment rate data presenting accurate percentages that are within compliance. It is predicted there will be a decrease in the number of direct Regional Crisis Calls due to the use of 9-8-8 in the upcoming months.
4. **Administrative Updates – CSD SCRBH – Justin Johnson, SCRBH (ASO)**
 - a. **Community Services Department Name Change – Justin Johnson, Intern Director:** A brief update was provided on the Community Services Department (CSD) name change effective January 1, 2023.
 - b. **ISW SB-SBIRT Update – Katy Rice:** A brief update on the School Base Screening, Brief, Intervention, and Referral for Treatment project (SB-SBIRT) was provided. SB-SBIRT screens students and provides immediate referral for assistance by end of day. Two (2) schools in the West Valley school district started the SB-SBIRT program in October 2022. The SB-SBIRT Program has now expanded to include a phase 2 project in conjunction with ESD101 in Freeman and Riverside School Districts.
 - c. **AOT & MRSS Update – Justin Johnson:** A brief update was provided. The Assisted Outpatient Treatment (AOT) was expanded last year, creating more engagement from the community and allow community member to make referrals for AOT. Mobile Response and Stability Services (MRSS) allows assistance for an additional fourteen (14) days after a crisis. MRSS allows the mental health care provider and/or peers to provide additional stabilization after the crisis to prevent hospitalizations.
5. **Consumer Consultation Panel (CCP) Report – Tom Gose** read the minutes from the September, October, November, and December 2022 meetings.
6. **Board Comments – 2023 Board Election Officers:**
 - a. Election for Chair: Kim Taylor accepted the nomination for Board Chair; a motion was made, and the board approved.
 - b. Election for Vice-Chair: Andrew Van Winkle accepted the nomination for Board Vice-Chair; a motion was made, and the board approved.
7. **Public Comments – None.**

A motion was made, and the board approved to adjourn the meeting.
