



**SPOKANE COUNTY DUI THERAPEUTIC COURT
ORIENTATION PHASE TEST**

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Instructions: Read each of the following statements. Check the box next to “T” for True and “F” for False for each of the statements based on your research. Once completed, review your answers with your Probation Officer.

1. T F I may use over-the-counter medication as long as it doesn't contain alcohol.
2. T F It is okay for me to miss a random test as long as I call Probation ahead of time.
3. T F I can have one glass of wine at my best friend's wedding.
4. T F My graduation will be delayed 90 days if I relapse, “No Show” for a random test, provide a dilute specimen or if I'm unable to provide a specimen.
5. T F I must complete the MRT program as a requirement to graduate.
6. T F I can move anywhere as long as I notify my Probation Officer within (7) days.
7. T F I must be ready to provide a breath test and adequate urine sample each time I test.
8. T F I may not possess any alcohol or non-prescribed drugs.
9. T F During Phase 1, I will attend court (1) time per week.
10. T F Random testing can be increased or decreased at any time.
11. T F In order to graduate, I must be employed FT or working toward a degree.
12. T F I must report as directed to Probation even if I'm having a bad day.
13. T F It is okay to live with someone who uses drugs.
14. T F If I live with someone who is on probation or parole, I need to tell my Probation Officer.
15. T F If I can't provide a urine sample when asked, it will be considered a program violation.
16. T F If the police stop me for a traffic violation, I need to tell my Probation Officer.
17. T F I may use prescription medications without informing the DUI Court team.
18. T F It takes a minimum of 14 months to complete the DUI Court program.

- 19. T F If I'm unable to provide a urine specimen, it will be considered negative as long as I test the following day.
- 20. T F It is okay to ride my bicycle while intoxicated because it's safer than driving a car.
- 21. T F If I am in the DUI Court program, it is okay to drive a car even if my license is suspended.
- 22. T F A urine screen that is dilute will be considered a program violation.
- 23. T F I may not leave the county without prior approval from my Probation Officer.
- 24. T F If I relapse, I will be required to go to jail for 30 days.
- 25. T F I can take over-the-counter diet aids as long as it is an herbal supplement.
- 26. T F I can leave a message on my Probation Officer's phone instead of coming in for my appointment.
- 27. T F I can be late for Court as long as I show up.
- 28. T F If I "No Show" for a random test, it will be considered a program violation.
- 29. T F I can change my Probation Officer if I don't feel that she/he is being fair.
- 30. T F I need to be violation-free for a minimum of 30 days in order to progress to the next phase of the DUI Court program.
