

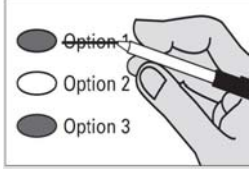
**Instructions**

Marking Your Ballot



Completely fill in the oval to the left of your choice.  
 Vote for only one candidate in each contest. Use a dark blue or black pen.  
 Unless specifically allowed by law, more than one vote for a contest will be an overvote and no votes for that ballot contest will be counted. To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the name on the line provided and fill in the oval.

Correcting Your Ballot



If you make a correction or mismark your ballot, draw a line through the entire response. You then have the option of making another choice.  
 In order for your ballot to be counted, it must be either postmarked or deposited at a designated deposit site no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day (August 1, 2017).

Proposition No. 1  
City of Liberty Lake  
Town Square Community Center  
General Obligation Bonds -  
\$9,000,000

The City Council of the City of Liberty Lake, adopted Ordinance No. 240, authorizing a proposition to fund the construction of a community center. This proposition would authorize the City to construct a community center adjacent to Town Square Park and other capital improvements by adding community meeting space, consolidating City services and relocating the existing library; issue \$9,000,000 of general obligation bonds maturing within 30 years; and levy annual excess property tax levies to pay such bonds, as provided in Ordinance No. 240.
