

## JUNKED VEHICLES

This brochure is intended to provide a brief summary of Spokane County Junked Vehicle Storage Regulations for *all* Rural and Urban Residential zones.

The Spokane County Zoning Code (14.300.100) defines a *Junked Vehicle* as any vehicle meeting two (2) of the following criteria:

- 1. Is extensively damaged, for example, broken windshields, missing tires/wheels, or missing other parts.
- 2. Is or appears to be inoperable.
- 3. Is not currently licensed.

Spokane County Zoning Code sections 14.618.300(5)c (Rural) and 14.606.300(6)c (Urban Residential) regulates the <u>storage of all junked vehicles</u>

**Two (2)** and only 2 junked vehicles are allowed to be stored on a parcel, <u>PROVIDED</u> that those 2 vehicles are <u>COMPLETELY</u> sight screened from a non-elevated view with a fence or dense landscaping. Tarps can not be used for such screening.

Additional Junked Vehicles can only be stored inside a completely enclosed building with solid walls.
