IN THE MATTER OF CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION WHEREIN THE ELECTORS OF THE CITY OF AIRWAY HEIGHTS WILL VOTE ON WHETHER THE CITY OF AIRWAY HEIGHTS SHOULD BE ANNEXED INTO THE SPOKANE COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT

#### RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Constitution and laws of the State of Washington, Spokane County, Washington ("County") is a class A county duly organized and existing; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.01.030, the powers of the County can only be exercised through the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, Washington ("Board" or "Board of County Commissioners"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of RCW 36.32.120(6), the Board has the care of County property and the management of County funds and business; and

WHEREAS, the Spokane County Library District is a rural county library district duly organized and existing under the Constitution and laws of the State of Washington, specifically chapter 27.12 RCW; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 27.12.360, the City Council of the City of Airway Heights ("City") enacted Ordinance No. C-1002 (see Attachment A), declaring an intent to join the Spokane County Library District, and submitting to the qualified electors of the City at an election on August 1, 2023, a proposition authorizing the annexation of the City into the Spokane County Library District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Spokane County Library District enacted Resolution No. 23-01 (see Attachment B), concurring with the request of the City of Airway Heights to annex into the Spokane County Library District, and requesting that the Board of County Commissioners call a special election for the purpose of permitting consideration of the proposed annexation by the voters of the City of Airway Heights, and providing for other matters properly related thereto; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 27.12.360, the Board of Trustees of the Spokane County Library District sent a letter (see Attachment C) notifying the Board of County Commissioners of the Library District's concurrence with the City of Airway Height's request to annex into the Spokane County Library District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 27.12.370, the Board must, by resolution, call a special election to be held in the City of Airway Heights in accordance with RCW 29A.04.321 and RCW 29A.52.355; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 29A.04.321(2)(c), RCW 29A.04.311, and RCW 29A.24.050, the Board must present such resolution to the Spokane County Auditor no later than Friday, May 12, 2023, for a special election to be conducted on Tuesday, August 1, 2023;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Spokane County, pursuant to RCW 27.12.370, that a special election shall be held on Tuesday, August

1, 2023, wherein the ballot proposition in Section 2 of Ordinance No. C-1002 (see Attachment A) shall be submitted to the electors within the City of Airway Heights. The Spokane County Auditor shall provide notice of, and conduct, the special election in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.

#### ORDINANCE NO. C-1002

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AIRWAY HEIGHTS, WASHINGTON, DECLARING AN INTENT TO JOIN THE SPOKANE COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT, AND SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE CITY AT AN ELECTION AUGUST 1, 2023, A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING THE ANNEXATION OF THE CITY INTO THE SPOKANE COUNTY LIBRARY DISTRICT; AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Airway Heights, Washington (the "City") has authority under RCW 27.12.360 to initiate by ordinance the inclusion of the City into the Spokane County Library District, Spokane County, Washington (the "SCLD"), a rural county library district duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the Constitution and the laws of the state of Washington; and

WHEREAS, the City seeks to join the SCLD, and has directed the preparation of this ordinance declaring its intent to join the SCLD; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with RCW 27.12.360, the City has notified the State Librarian of this ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the SCLD Board of Trustees concurs in the annexation of the City into the SCLD; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with chapter 27.12 RCW, the City desires to submit a proposition to the City's voters to authorize such annexation, and to request that Spokane County take all necessary steps to place such a proposition on the August 1, 2023 ballot; and

WHEREAS, upon annexation, the City would become part of the SCLD, and the real property within the City would be subject to taxation by the SCLD; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the public interest will be served thereby;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Airway Heights does ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1.</u> Findings. The City Council hereby declares the City's intent to join the SCLD, and finds that the public interest will be served thereby. The City Council further finds that the State Librarian was notified of this proposed annexation on <u>March 12, 2023</u>, and that the SCLD Board of Trustees concurs with the annexation of the City into the SCLD, all pursuant to RCW 27,12.360.

Section 2. Election. The Spokane County Board of Commissioners is requested to authorize the Spokane County Auditor to call and conduct an election to be held in the City in the manner provided by law on August 1, 2023, in conjunction with any other matter that may be scheduled for ballot on that date, for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors of the City by mail-in ballot for their approval or rejection, a proposition in substantially the following form:

## Explanatory Statement – Proposition No. 1

If approved, this proposition authorizes the City of Airway Heights ("City") to be annexed into the Spokane County Library District ("SCLD"). SCLD operates and maintains 11 libraries in Spokane County, including the libraries that serve City residents. In exchange for these services, the City currently pays SCLD approximately 24% of its general property tax levy—the same levy from which the City funds all general City services. If voters approve this proposition, SCLD would levy property owners directly for library services instead of charging the City. The City could then redirect these savings to fire and emergency medical services, and other City costs. Annexation into SCLD would not impact the library services that City residents currently receive.

If approved, beginning in 2025, citizens of the City would have access to services provided by the SCLD, and the real property within the City would be subject to the SCLD property tax levy. The SCLD's levy in 2023 was \$0.34/\$1,000 of assessed value.
