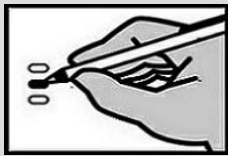
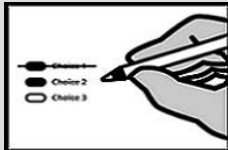


Sample Ballot

Proposition No. 1
City of Cheney
Public Safety Levy

Proposition restoring the City of Cheney's regular property tax levy.

The Cheney City Council adopted Resolution No. E-930. This proposition provides funds for the purposes of public safety services, restoring the maximum regular levy for collection in 2022 to \$3.10 per \$1,000 of assessed value; sets levy increases in 2023 through 2027 at 106%; provides the 2027 levy amount will be used for computing limitations for subsequent levies under chapter 84.55 RCW; exempts qualifying low-income seniors, disabled veterans and others from levy increases under RCW 84.36.381.
