

Official Ballot Spokane County Washington March 10, 2020 Presidential Primary

To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, write the name on the line provided and fill in the oval.



If you make a correction or mismark your ballot, draw a line through the entire response. You then have the option of making another choice. In order for your ballot to be counted, it must either be postmarked or deposited at a designated deposit site no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day (March 10, 2020).
